TEAM - EVENT FORMAT / SCORING



- Gender parity
- 2M + 2F
- Maximum squad of 3+3?
- Pools followed by knock-out
- All matches: best of 3 to 11 points
- 2-all draw: count-back on games, then points



EVENT STRUCTURE & TIMING

- Continental and sub-Continental Championships to qualify
- World Cup Finals to be discussed
- World Cup Structure
 - 16 then 20 and 24 teams

- Top nations from Regions qualify for next World Cup Finals
